## Major in English/Secondary Education

Students seeking to teach English at the secondary level should complete the English Major (B.A) (https://catalog.neiu.edu/arts-sciences/english/english/), and then apply to the Teacher Certification/M.A.T. cohort program in the College of Education during their last term as undergraduates. Transfer students and others who have completed a minimum of 60 hours toward their B.A. degree in English should see advisors about our Accelerated Program toward the M.A.T. degree. Qualified students may **count the first four courses in the M.A.T. program as their last four courses of the B.A. degree**, hence saving money (graduate level tuition is slightly higher) and up to a full term's time-to-degree.
